The **Care Sector Communication Aid** is a book designed to help carers & people with cognitive loss carry out everyday tasks & activities.

- Over 60 laminated (easy to clean) A5 pages
- The book is split into four main sections, these are Getting Dressed, Daily Routine, Food and Drink, and Medical
- Each section is colour coded in the book to easily change between them
- Most common daily activities are included, such as; getting dressed/undressed, showering/bathing, brushing teeth, eating a meal, listening to music, etc
- A selection of common items around the home, such as; televisions, radios, different items of clothing, different bathroom/hygiene products, etc
- Many of the double-page activity spreads (see product photo) include green ticks & red crosses; this allows the carer to ask the individual whether they would like to perform a specific task, the person can then answer by pointing at the tick or cross

The book also contains a double-spread whiteboard page for personalised messages/images, a wipe clean clock-face, the complete alphabet, numbers from 1-20.

There are also labels at the back of the book that correspond to each individual task or item, these can be added to the pages so that individuals have both image & matching text.

- Alzheimer's & dementia
- Traumatic brain injuries, such as strokes
